OSR Required Each Day.

Squirrel, Rabbits, and Hares: Oct. 18, Nov. 1, and Jan. 13 (bag limit 10 squirrels and 3 rabbits per day). Shooting hours end at noon. ATVs are recommended. No dogs allowed.

Means Restriction: Firearms are restricted to shotguns and rimfire rifles only. Air rifles may be used for hunting squirrels, rabbits and hares only.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS: Gates open one hour before legal shooting hours. All hunters must check-in and check-out at designated check station. An **Annual Public Hunting Permit** is required to participate during the Squirrel hunts. All fees waived for persons under 17 years old accompanied by a permitted supervising adult. No target practice allowed.

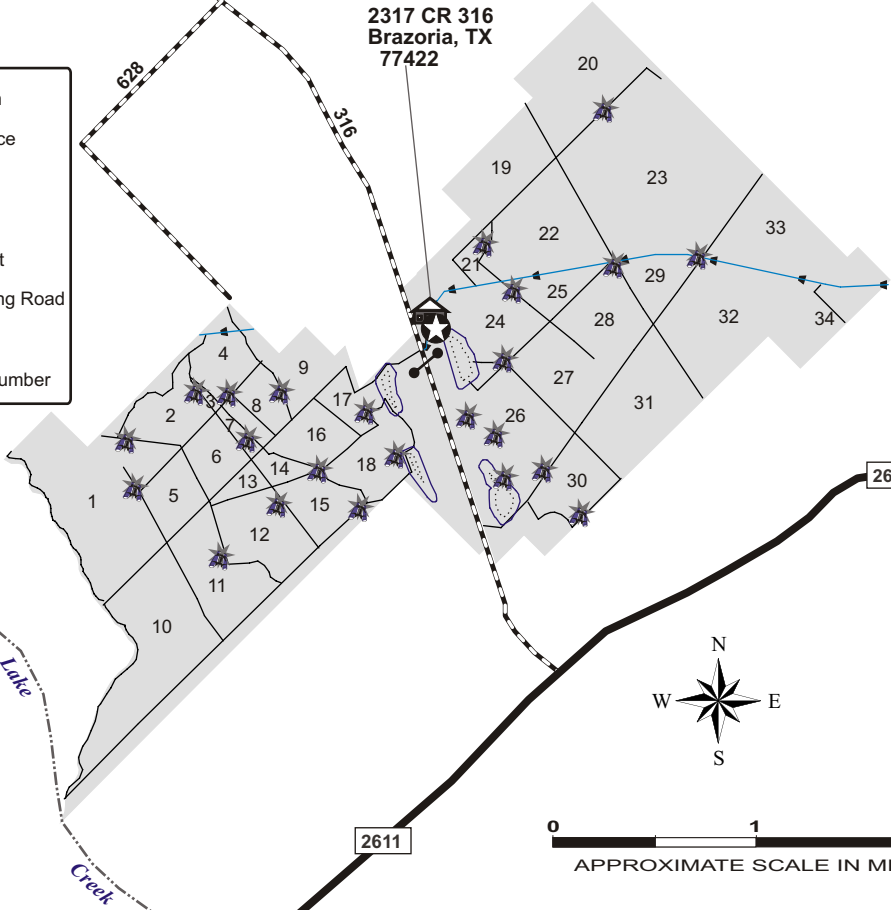
