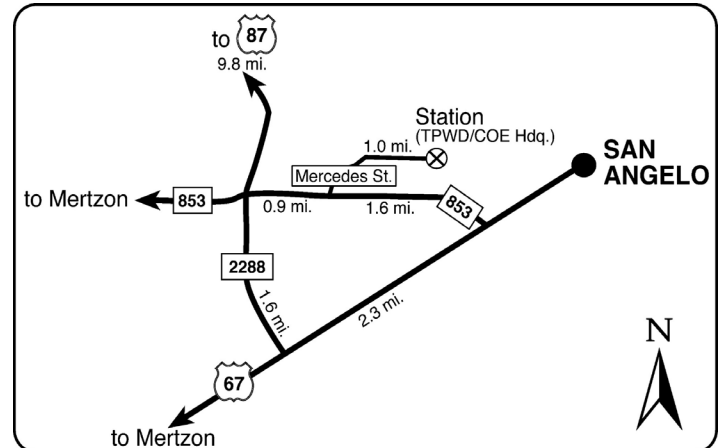




# San Angelo State Park

## Background

San Angelo State Park, consisting of approximately 7,677 total acreage (2,448 acres for APH hunting and 5,229 additional acres for Special Permit hunting for deer and turkey) along the western shore of O.C. Fisher Reservoir, is adjacent to and northwest of the city of San Angelo in Tom Green County. The hunter check station/registration station is located at the park headquarters near the south end of the dam and may be accessed via Mercedes Street off of FM 853 (Arden Road) Approximately 1 mile east of its intersection with FM 2288. It is the hunter's responsibility to observe property boundary lines.



All persons using the park will be held accountable for their actions and should conduct themselves accordingly. For more information about the park, call (325) 949-4757.

## Hunting Information

Hunters that are drawn for special permits should report to the park headquarters by 11:00 a.m. at 3900 Mercedes for orientation on the first day of their assigned hunt period. **Hunters must contact the area as soon as possible if they are unable to attend their accepted hunt or not able to arrive on the first day for orientation.** Standby hunters should report to the park by 10:45 a.m. on the first day of the desired hunt period to complete the sign-in process. Standby hunters will be drawn as vacancies permit. Following a brief orientation, hunters will be assigned blinds in which they are to hunt. Hunting will end at 12:00 p.m. on the final day of the assigned hunt period. The Youth Only hunt ends at sundown on the final day of the assigned hunt period.

Hunters must wear a minimum of 400 square inches of hunter orange material, including 144 square inches appearing on both chest and back and orange head wear is required.

Non-permitted visitors and family members will not be allowed to enter the hunt area during hunts. However, a non-hunting adult assisting a permitted hunter with mobility disabilities will be allowed.

Hunters are reminded that they must have a valid Texas Hunting License and any stamp required by statute. It is no longer necessary to use a hunting license tag or bonus tag for a deer taken during a Special Permit drawn hunt however a TPWD Legal Deer Tag, issued at the area, must be attached to a harvested deer prior to leaving the hunt area.

Hunters 17 years of age and older must have in their possession a valid I.D. Hunter Safety Education is required of Texas hunters born on or after September 2, 1971 (see the Texas Parks & Wildlife Outdoor Annual for more information).

### **Annual Public Hunting Information**

All Annual Public Hunting Permit holders must perform on-site registration upon arrival at the South Shore Gate House. Hunting compartments, maps and vehicle permits will be assigned at the South Shore Gate House.
